Godly Leaders Upholding the Truth

1 Timothy 3

1 Timothy is God's instruction manual for the conduct of the church, conduct that is rooted in the gospel. The true gospel always leads to godliness in the lives of those who believe the gospel and trust in Christ. How we live, how we pray, how we worship, how we serve, how we are led – all are tangible ways that the church lifts up and lives out the gospel for others to see, hear, and believe. In chapter three, Paul explains the required characteristics for the church's leaders. The church's health and spiritual growth depend in large part on the kind of leadership it is following. When biblically qualified men are leading and serving the church with character and skill, it is a great blessing for the unity, holiness, and vitality of the church. The local church lifts up the truth of God for others to see and defends it against adversaries when it is led by those who are biblically called and spiritually qualified.

The Church: The Pillar and Buttress of the Truth

The Elders: The Servant Leaders of the Church

Appointed to faithfully lead under the authority of Christ

Called to lovingly shepherd the flock of Christ

Responsible for accurately teaching the word of Christ

Responsible for consistently modeling the character of Christ

The Deacons: The Leading Servants of the Church

Exemplify Christ-like character as they serve the needs of the church

Demonstrate gospel-confidence as they as they assist the elders of the church

Guard and protect the essential unity of the church
