Perilous Times and the Corrupt Influence of Perilous Men 2 Timothy 3:1-9

Main point: Avoid sin and corrupt influences, and embrace the Gospel alone as the true redemptive power of God.

- 1. Be Aware of corruption in your midst.
 - A. Who the false teachers are (vs. 1-5)
 - B. What they do (vs. 6-9)
- 2. Avoid those who corrupt the Gospel (v. 5)

3. Know that the Truth will be known and prevail (v. 9)
