

Sermon Notes

Behold your gods, O Israel! 1 Kings 12:25-33

We saw last week from the first half of chapter 12 that our sovereign God is sovereign and providential, even in the midst of sin, corruption, and rebellion. While that truth certainly colors the way we read the rest of this chapter, we are also reminded of the painful truth that sin always causes a mess. The ripples can be unfathomably wide, both in who it affects and how long the effects can be felt. Sin pushes us deeper into the way things ought not be, and can cause us to compound the consequences in our response. That is the picture we see in v.25-33.

"And Jeroboam said in his heart..." We cannot follow both the Lord and our hearts.

"The heart of this people will turn ... they will kill me..." Misplaced fear leads to misplaced trust.

"This thing became a sin..." The appearance of religion does not equate with devotion to God.

"Let the Word of Christ dwell in you(all) richly teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom..." - Colossians 3:16a
