## Sermon Notes

### **The Word of the Lord = LIFE**

1 Kings 17 (pew Bible pg. 299)

The God of the Bible has no rivals. "...The Lord is God, there is none besides Him." "There is no other." (Deut. 4:35, 39). God is Creator, and all things consist in Him. He and He alone gives life.

Ahab denied God as the one true LIVING God by embracing the foolishness of the Israelite kings before him. He and his wicked wife, Jezebel encouraged the worship of the Phoenician gods, particularly Baal. God will not share the covenant love and worship that He alone is due.

The Word of the Lord is life. To reject His Word is to reject Him which leads to death. One author defined "The Word of the Lord" as God's purpose expressed in words. Jesus responded to the devil when He was tempted in the wilderness by quoting Deuteronomy 8. He said, "It is written, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God." (Matt. 4:4). We need God. We should depend on Him, trust Him and Him alone. We need God like we need food and water.

God sends His prophet to deliver HIS WORD. Elijah is "The prophet". Elijah confronts the evil king and things get very interesting. This passage is a demonstration of the reality that when God speaks, lives are changed, and miracles happen.

1. The Word of the Lord confronts sin
2. The Word of the Lord provides direction and protection
3. The Word of the Lord supplies provision
4. The Word of the Lord conquers death
